Here and now, the Island Foundation is poised to help strengthen the nonprofit and philanthropic sectors. With established staff, and with the next generation of trustees fully entrenched and at the helm, we are positioned to continue a legacy of thoughtful philanthropy.

Moving forward, we remain committed to our belief that our grantees have the answers, and we hope our grants will foster their questions, solutions, and dreams.

GRANTMAKING PRIORITIES



The Island Foundation's grant priorities fall within four major categories:

Environment, New Bedford, Alternative Education, and Global.

The Foundation supports projects in coastal areas of Maine, Massachusetts, and Rhode Island and selected international locations.

For the last two decades, the Foundation has focused a significant portion of its financial resources on Southeastern Massachusetts, where its office is located. Here the Board seeks to understand how communities grow sustainably and equitably, how to increase educational opportunities, how rural and urban economies are intertwined, and how to best protect working landscapes and the people who rely upon these areas for their livelihoods. In funding in a few specific areas, the Board believes it will have the most impact.





ENVIRONMENT

In Southeastern Massachusetts, Maine, and Rhode Island, the Island Foundation promotes the conservation of marine and coastal resources. For many years, the Foundation has given priority to North Atlantic right whale research, protection of coastal waterbird habitat, and preservation of coastal lands.

More recently, the Board has been interested in new initiatives that:

- link climate change, renewable energy, and regional planning and support those most impacted by climate change;
- support working landscapes (sustainable agriculture and community-based fisheries) and the people who rely on them for their livelihoods;
- help local conservation organizations strengthen their own capacity;
- connect community health, quality of life, and environmental conservation; and
- promote environmental justice and seek to include the voices of those most affected by environmental harms.

ALTERNATIVE EDUCATION

The Island Foundation supports a limited number of experiential education programs, after-school programs, and alternative education schools, with an emphasis on ensuring educational access for underserved populations. Drawing on its tradition of seeking alternative and unconventional approaches, the Island Foundation looks for informal and school-based programs that connect young people to their natural world, foster an appreciation for community service, and respect individuals with diverse backgrounds and learning styles. Maritime trades, hands-on marine education, and programs that increase access and opportunity for at-risk youth are of particular interest.



NEW BEDFORD

The Foundation works with organizations that promote progressive social change and combat discrimination in all its forms in New Bedford. In this historic city, the Foundation supports youth programs, community development, arts and culture, and basic needs. The Foundation funds groups that have community-wide recognition and support and demonstrate a positive vision for the present and future of New Bedford.

Within the New Bedford program area, the Board currently seeks proposals addressing:

- youth educational attainment, life skills, and career preparation, with an emphasis on workforce development for at-risk youth ages 16-24;
- strategies to address food insecurity;
- assistance for immigrants;
- activities that increase civic engagement, access, and inclusion;
- appreciation for the history and cultures represented in this community; and
- professional development/capacity building for the nonprofit sector.

GLOBAL

From local to global, we live in world where everything is interconnected. And by making connections to the issues it cares about, the Foundation is able to have an impact on change that supports a just and sustainable world.

The Foundation supports a small number of global programs that mirror the values in its other priority areas, and it also supports projects that:

- ensure the rights of indigenous peoples and women;
- protect those most vulnerable to climate change;
- empower local communities to drive their own development;
- provide access to quality healthcare for the poor; and
- promote sexual and reproductive health education and rights.

GRANT APPLICATION GUIDELINES

Who is eligible to apply to the Island Foundation?

The Island Foundation supports 501(c)(3) nonprofit organizations in Maine, Massachusetts, and Rhode Island. The Board funds some groups outside of these areas when their programs relate to work the Foundation is supporting within its programmatic and geographic priority areas. On a case-by-case basis, the Foundation provides funding to groups without nonprofit status that use a fiscal sponsor.

The Island Foundation accepts both general operating and project-focused grant requests and occasionally makes multi-year grant commitments to organizations it has supported for many years.

How do I apply to the Island Foundation?

1) Initial Contact—To determine if your request could be considered for funding by the Foundation, you may either call or write to the Foundation. The Foundation's contact information is:

2) Letter of Inquiry/Full Proposal—If a Letter of Inquiry or Full Proposal is requested, please submit the following information through the Foundation's online grants management system:

- One page cover letter on your letterhead that specifies the amount of funding sought, briefly describes your organization and its mission, and gives a summary of the proposal idea.
- Three to five page proposal including a brief history of the organization, project need, project goals, methods used to meet your goals, measures of success, and qualifications of your organization and staff.
- A project budget (income and expenses) and past and current year budgets for the overall organization.



- Most recent financial statement or audit.
- List of Board of Directors and staff.
- Internal Revenue Service (IRS) tax determination letter indicating 501(c)(3) status of the organization. If you are using a fiscal sponsor, include the 501(c)(3) letter of your fiscal sponsor and a letter from them indicating their willingness to assume fiscal and administrative reporting responsibility for the grant.
- Supplementary materials: annual reports, newsletters, media coverage, and/or brochures.

The Island Foundation accepts letters of inquiry and full proposals:

- March 1st
- June 1st
- September 1st
- December 1st

If these dates fall on a weekend, the deadline is the first following workday. Decisions are made within a month and grants are distributed by approximately the 15th of the following month.

Annual progress reports and budget information (income and expenses) are required of every grantee.

What requests are looked upon favorably?

The Island Foundation accepts proposals for projects in the four priority areas of Environment, New Bedford, Education, and Global.

The Foundation seeks organizations that are innovative, well-regarded, sustainable, nondiscriminatory in any way, and able to demonstrate the impact of their work. The Foundation also gives preference to organizations

based in and working within a community, particularly in regards to the city of New Bedford.

What does the Island Foundation not fund?

The Foundation does not support proposals outside its priority areas (issue and/or geographic) or requests from individuals, for-profit businesses, or religious groups.


Penance and Special Projects



Island Foundation Five-Year Funding: 2010 - 2014


